




Finding your way around an internet page


To go onto the internet I need to use a **browser** For example, **Google** and **Firefox** are browsers

When I open up an internet page there are several parts:

· The browser menu in green



The website in red



The tabs in blue





I go onto the internet with a **computer**:

The browser menu at the top of the screen always has the same symbols:

On a Windows computer



On a Mac - Apple



• The cross closes an internet page



• The double arrow or the double square increases or reduces the size of the window





• The line hides an internet window without closing it





• At the top of the screen to the left there is also:



An arrow pointing towards the left to go back



An arrow pointing towards the right to go to the next page



A rotating arrow to update the page
